SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 72, L. D. 156, An Act to Amend
the Exemption in the Sales and Use Tax
Law Respecting Hospitals

Amend said Bill by adding thereto a new paragraph numbered
XII-A to read as follows:

'XII-A. Sales to proprietors of unincorporated hospitals.
Sales to proprietors of unincorporated hospitals of hospital
supplies and equipment. By "hospital supplies and equipment"
is intended all tangible personal property bought for the care,
treatment and housing of patients of the hospital or any other
purpose necessarily incident to the operation of the hospital.'
