STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Commissioners of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to salary of commissioners of Aroostook county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, \$1,100 \$1,500, except that I member of the board, to be designated by the board, who shall devote each full working day to his duties including superintendence of the county buildings, shall receive annually the sum of \$3,000 \$4,500.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1953.
