STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to an Appropriation to Buy Indian Baskets.

Indian baskets; appropriation for. Resolved: There is hereby appropriated to the department of health and welfare from the general fund of the state the sum of \$3,000 to be used by said department to purchase baskets from the Indians. Said baskets may be sold by the department for their cost. The money received from the sale of the baskets shall be credited to this fund which shall be a revolving fund and shall not lapse.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The market for Indian baskets is in the summer. During the winter there is a need for income among the Indians and it is hoped that by this method the department can provide some income for the Indians during the months when they need it most.
