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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Kennebunkport.**

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**Town of Kennebunkport; money reallocated. Resolved:** That the sum of \$1,300 appropriated in favor of the town of Kennebunkport, by the 95th legislature for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, for the repair of state aid highway #2, beginning at a point about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile south of Wildes district fire station, extending in a southerly direction about 1,000 feet, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended to aid in repairing the road beginning at the junction of North street, so called, near the residence of the late Frank Meserve and running northeasterly to the Hutchin's school, thence easterly to route #9; this being a continuation of work done under previous special resolve.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above sum of \$1,300 was not used for the repair of state aid highway #2 and it is requested that this money be made available for use on the above described road.
