STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Creating Deputy Inland Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 19-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 19-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 19-A. Deputy wardens. The commissioner may appoint deputy inland fish and game wardens to assist and aid the inland fish and game wardens in their duties. The appointment and discharge of such deputy wardens shall be in writing and they shall have the same powers and be subject to the same laws as inland fish and game wardens. All such appointments shall terminate any time within the calendar year in which the appointment was made.'
