STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Length of Trout.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 37, amended. Subsection II of the 1st paragraph of section 37 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'II. A trout less than 67 inches in length;'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 37, amended. Subsection II of the 2nd paragraph of section 37 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'II. A trout less than 7 10 inches in length;'
- Sec. 3. R. S., c. 33, § 38, amended. Section 38 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 38. Penalty for violation. Whoever violates any provision of the 3 preceding sections shall pay a fine of not less than \$10 \$25, nor more than \$30 \$50, and costs of prosecution, for each offense; and in addition thereto, \$1 \$3 for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of said sections.'
