AN ACT Relating to Admission to Practice Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 93, § 4-A, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4-A of chapter 93 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 70 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Such equivalent preliminary education shall be proved by presenting to said board within ~~6~~ **10** years after such person receives his discharge from such armed forces, his diploma or certificate of graduation from such secondary school and his honorable discharge from such armed forces.’
