COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 80, L. D. 186, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Guaranteed Loans to Veterans."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the following:

"Sec. 4. R. S., c. 153, c 35, amended. The 1st sentence of
section 35 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes, as amended,
is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'A married person, widow or widower, of any age, may own in
his or her own right real and personal estate acquired by
descent, gift or purchase; and may manage, sell, mortgage,
convey and devise the same by will, without the joinder or
assent of husband or wife; but such conveyance without the
joinder or assent of the husband or wife shall not bar his or
her right and interest by descent in the estate so conveyed.'"
