HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 191, L. D. 202, Bill, "An Act Regulating Liquor Advertising."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

R. S. c. 57, Sec. 59, amended. The first sentence of section 59 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No advertising of liquor within the state shall be permitted except in such form as may be specifically authorized by the commission, provided that radio, billboards, signs, newspapers, magazines, and periodicals may carry advertising subject to the regulations of the commission; and

further provided that no television programs advertising liquor originating in the state and no advertising of liquor in television films to be used in programs originating in the state shall be permitted except in such form as may be specifically authorized by the commission and subject to the regulation of the commission.'
