STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Funeral Expenses of Deceased Recipients of Old Age Assistance and Aid to the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 269, amended. Section 269 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 269. Funeral expenses. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$150 shall be paid by the state if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 291, amended. Section 291 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 291. Funeral expenses. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$150 shall be paid by the state if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.'
