RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Ponds in Hancock County.

Fishing in certain ponds in Hancock county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily limit of 5 trout taken from the waters of Goose Pond, Mitchell Pond and Second Pond, all in the town of Dedham, and Moulton Pond in Dedham and Bucksport, all in the county of Hancock.
