STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Westbrook Seminary and Junior College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Degrees. In addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted to Westbrook Seminary and Junior College, under the name of Westbrook Seminary, by chapter 143 of the private and special laws of 1831, and by chapter 252 of the private and special laws of 1863, and all other acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto, and by chapter 63 of the private and special laws of 1929, said Westbrook Seminary and Junior College, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by junior colleges offering a two year curriculum, the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Applied Science.
