**AN ACT Relating to Clerks for Voting District in Town of Cranberry Isles.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 5, § 14, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 14 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘For each voting place in cities and towns, 4 clerks, and for each voting place in plantations and for each island ward of the city of Portland and for the island district of the town of Cumberland **and the districts in the town of Cranberry Isles**, 2 clerks shall be appointed.’
