STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Apple Storage and Packing Room at Highmoor Farm.

Apple storage and packing room; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$65,000 in favor of the University of Maine to construct and equip a new apple storage and packing room at Highmoor Farm; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A room is needed for research studies in marketing. The storage will permit holding the main crop of apples, which previously had to be sold when picked, so that research may be conducted on more efficient methods of handling, reduction in bruising, improved containers and better merchandising.
