IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Aurora.

Town of Aurora; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$674.76 from the general fund of the state to be paid to the town of Aurora to reimburse said town for fighting fire on Spruce Mountain, so called, in Aurora.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town paid the entire cost of fighting this fire, which amounted to \$1,526.86. This was more than 1% of its valuation. The state reimbursed the town $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% of the valuation, in the amount of \$426.05, leaving a balance of \$674.76. The fire was in the summer of 1948.
