STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Certain Education Institutions from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14-A, § 10, sub-§ XIII, amended. Subsection XIII of section 10 of chapter 14-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'XIII. Hospitals and churches. Sales to hospitals and regularly organized churches or houses of religious worship, privately operated, non-profit, education institutions recognized as such by the state commissioner of education, excepting such sales, storage or use in activities as are mainly commercial enterprises.'
