AN ACT Creating Placentia Island, Hancock County, as a Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. Section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto, in alphabetical order, the following :

'Placentia Island: The whole of Placentia island in the plantation of Long Island, Hancock county.'
