RESOLVE, Opening Moose River to Fishing.

Moose river; opened to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Moose river from the Brassua dam to Moosehead lake, to fishing, from May 1st to September 15th of each year.
