IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Careless Shooting of Humans While Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 125, amended. The 1st sentence of section 125 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'Whoever while on a hunting trip, or in pursuit of wild game or game birds, shoots and wounds or kills any human being, shall be deemed prima facie to be negligent or careless and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than 10 years.'
