### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Throwing Substances at Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 124, § 25-A, additional. Chapter 124 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 25-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 25-A. Substances thrown at vehicles. Any person throwing or hurling or causing to be thrown or hurled, any object or substance at any moving vehicle, or at and upon any stationary vehicle upon any highway, street or way shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$10, or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days; and for any 2nd or subsequent offense, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200, or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months.'
