COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 234, L. D. 259, Bill, "An Act Relating to the taking of Soft Shell Clams, Quahogs and Mussels in the town of Jonesport."

Amend said Bill by striking out all after the enacting clause, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Taking of soft shell clams, quahogs and mussels in

Jonesport: penalty. It shall be unlawful for any person, not a legal resident of the town of Jonesport, in the county of Washington, to dig or to take soft shell clams, quahogs or mussels, for any purpose, in the coastal waters and flats within the limits of the said town of Jonesport.

Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall, for each offense, be punished by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than \$25, or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
