STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Throwing Substances on Highways Likely to Cause Fires.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 85, § 34-A, additional. Chapter 85 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 34-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 34-A. Throwing substances on highways; penalty. It shall be unlawful to drop or throw from any vehicle upon a public or private way a lighted cigarette, cigar, match or live ashes or any substance or thing in and of itself likely to cause a fire from March 1st to December 1st of each year.

Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than \$50.'
