AN ACT Relating to Liquor Billboards and Signs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 58, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 58 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person ~~except a wholesaler or manufacturer~~ shall advertise or permit to be advertised on the outside of any licensed premises, or on any building, grounds or premises, under his control, contiguous or adjacent to the licensed premises ~~by more than + outside sign~~ the fact that the licensee has for sale any liquor, or any brand of such liquor, or the price at which liquor is sold by the licensee, or display on the outside of any licensed premises any other advertisement which would indicate any reference whatsoever to liquor.'
