AN ACT Relating to Reports and Health Certificates of Chiropractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 65, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 65 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 11. Certain laws applicable. All laws, rules and regulations now in force in this state or which shall hereafter be enacted, for the purpose of regulating the reporting of contagious diseases and deaths to the proper authorities and to which the registered practitioner of medicine is subject, shall apply equally to the practitioner of chiropractic **and all reports and health certificates made by the practitioner of chiropractic shall be accepted by the officers of the departments to which the same are made equally with the reports and health certificates of doctors of medicine.'**
