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**AN ACT Relating to Removal of Parked Motor Vehicles.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 19, § 108, amended.** Section 108 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

**‘An officer may cause any vehicle so parked on any way so as to interfere with or hinder the removal of snow or the normal movement of traffic to be removed from the way and placed in a suitable parking place, at the expense of the owner of such vehicle. Neither the state nor the officer shall be liable for any damage that may be caused by such removal.’**
