STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sunday Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 66, repealed and replaced. Section 66 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 66. Sunday hunting. It shall be lawful to hunt on Sunday after 1 P. M. eastern standard time.'
