**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Mosquito Brook, Metallic Brook and
Mill Brook, County of Oxford.**

Fishing in certain brooks; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to make illegal all fishing from $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset to $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise and all bait fishing from shore or dock at mouth of Mosquito brook, Metallic brook and Mill brook, all tributaries of Richardson lake, county of Oxford.
