COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 265, L. D. 295, Resolve
Regulating Fishing in Coffee Pond,
Cumberland County.

Amend said Resolve by adding after the title the following
emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed
by the legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment; and

Whereas, Coffee Pond is a small pond and there is danger
of the fish being depleted between the 15th of April and the
time this Resolve would go into effect unless passed as an
emergency measure; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution and
require the following legislation as immediately necessary for
the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof,
before the period, the following: ', all other fish under the
general law'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof
the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
