RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Coffee Pond, Cumberland County.

Coffee pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting the daily bag limit on salmon, trout and togue in Coffee pond, Cumberland county, to 2 fish per person per day.
