IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing for Certain Fish in Coffee Pond, Cumberland County.

Coffee pond; ice fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Coffee pond, in Cumberland county, to ice fishing for salmon, trout and togue and to open said pond during February and March for the taking of smelts through the ice with a single hook and line and with a daily bag limit of 25 smelts per person per day.
