**RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Smelts in Little Big Wood Pond and
Long Pond in Somerset County.**

**Taking of smelts in Little Wood pond and Long pond, regulated. Re-
solved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and here-
by is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making it law-
ful to take smelts in the nighttime in Little Big Wood pond and in Long
pond in Somerset county by using not more than 5 lines in the waters which
have been opened to ice fishing by the commissioner.
