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**AN ACT Relating to the Examination of Insurance Agents.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 56, § 252, amended.** Section 252 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by repealing the 2nd paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph :

**'Provided that no personal examination or examination fee shall be required of a resident of the state when applying for a license to solicit insurance in behalf of any company or companies authorized to transact business in this state, when the annual premium on any policy to be sold under such license does not exceed \$2.'**
