**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Big Magalloway River in Oxford  
County.**

---

**Fishing in Big Magalloway river, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the Big Magalloway river, north of Aziscohos lake, in Oxford county, to fly fishing only with artificial unbaited flies, from September 1st to September 30th, inclusive, of each year, with a daily bag limit of 1 fish per person per day.
