IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Parmachenee Lake in Oxford County.

Fishing in Parmachenee lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Parmachenee lake, in Oxford county, to fly fishing and trolling only, with artificial unbaited flies and establishing a daily bag limit of I fish per person per day from September 1st to September 30th, inclusive, of each pear.
