**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Parmachenee Lake in Oxford County.**

---

**Fishing in Parmachenee lake, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Parmachenee lake, in Oxford county, to fly fishing and trolling only, with artificial unbaited flies and establishing a daily bag limit of 1 fish per person per day from September 1st to September 30th, inclusive, of each year.
