## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Arthur W. Kalloch of Thomaston.

Arthur W. Kalloch; pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$1,200 per year be, and hereby is, granted to Arthur W. Kalloch, of Thomaston, to be paid monthly from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System to increase the pension he is now receiving under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1953 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Kalloch is now receiving a pension of \$69.52 per month under the state retirement system. Mr. Kalloch worked at the State Prison from 1914 to 1939 when he retired.
