RESOLVE, in Favor of Frank B. Adams of Thomaston.

Frank B. Adams; retirement benefit increased. Resolved: That Frank B. Adams, of Thomaston, receive an increase in the amount of retirement benefit which he is presently receiving under the provisions of the Maine state retirement law in the amount of \$29.92 per month; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Adams was employed by the state, commencing March 8, 1928, as Superintendent of Farms at the State Prison. On January 25, 1949 he was struck on the head by convicts and since that time has suffered from nosebleeds. Mr. Adams is now drawing \$70.08 per month retirement.
