STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Duties of Court Stenographers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 185, amended. Section 185 of chapter 100 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'At the request of the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives, the chief justice of the supreme judicial court shall grant a leave of absence without pay, for not more than 5 months, to no more than 2 such stenographers for legislative reporting.'
