AN ACT Relating to Certain Violations by Liquor Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ II, ¶ N, additional. Subsection II of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered "N," to read as follows:

'N. Failure to have and maintain throughout the entire license period all of the requirements of definitions, laws, rules and regulations, necessary to qualify for a license. For this particular offense the commission shall be authorized to suspend licenses for an indefinite period of time until it is satisfied that the licensee has conformed to all qualifications required for licensing.'
