SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 137, L. D. 325, "Bill "An Act
to Make Uniform the Legal Hours for Sale
of Liquor."

Amend said Bill, by striking out the period in the next
to the last sentence of section 2 thereof and adding a comma,
~~and-fellows;~~ the following words:

1, except that from the last Sunday of April in each year to
the last Sunday in September in each year, during that period of
time generally known as daylight saving time, the hours of sale
of liquor as set forth in this chapter shall be set back one
hour.
