#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Bangor Public Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1925, c. 18, amended. Chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1925 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Organization of declared legal; authorized to hold property. The trustees of the Bangor public library, a corporation organized under the laws of this state and located at Bangor, county of Penobscot, which organization is hereby declared to be legal and valid, is hereby authorized and empowered for the purposes of its organization to receive, take and hold by deed, devise, bequest or otherwise, property, real, personal and mixed, to the amount of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) including all gifts, conveyances, bequests and devises, heretofore made to said corporation to any amount.'
