STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Powers of the Maine Turnpike Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 69, § 4, sub-§ (a), amended. Subsection (a) of section 4 of chapter 69 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

'Provided, however, the authority shall not lease, sell or otherwise convey, or allow to be used, any real or personal property or easements therein, franchises, buildings or structures with access to any part of the turnpike, or its approaches, for commercial purposes, with the exception of such gasoline filling stations, service and repair stations and restaurants as to service the needs of the travelling public while using the turnpike.'
