# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Number of Signatures on Certain Nomination Papers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 4, § 53, amended. The 1st sentence of section 53 of chapter 4 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Nominations of candidates for any offices to be filled by the voters of the state at large may be made by nomination papers signed in the aggregate for each candidate by not less than +,000 qualified voters of the state, the number of which shall not be less than 5% of the total vote for governor cast in the last gubernatorial election next preceding.'
