IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Vera A. Gordon, of West Sullivan.

Vera A. Gordon; retirement benefit. Resolved: That Vera A. Gordon, of West Sullivan, be given credit for an additional 6 months' teaching servso that she may be entitled to an additional retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes; provided that the said Vera A. Gordon shall contribute to the Maine state retirement system the sum of \$66.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Vera Gordon, of West Sullivan taught in the public schools for more than 34 years. She was forced to retire because of arthritis.
