AN ACT Relating to Fees of Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 166, sub-§ XXXVIII, amended. Subsection XXXVIII of section 166 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'**XXXVIII.** Every deputy sheriff while performing special duties under order of the sheriff shall receive for such services ~~§§~~ \$10 a day and such additional pay as the county commissioners may approve, together with necessary incidental expenses, to be paid from the county treasury, the bills for which shall be audited as provided in section 2 of chapter 137.'
