STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Approval by Towns of Agreements with Maine School Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 218, amended. The last paragraph of section 218 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section I of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No contract or agreement between a town or towns or community school district and the Authority shall be valid unless first approved by the inhabitants of the town or towns involved either individually or as members of a community school district by a vote of 2/3 of the inhabitants of such town or towns or of each town involved in the case of a community school district voting on this question.'
