STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Unemployment Compensation with Regard to Paid Holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 24, § 3, sub-§ XIX, amended. The 1st sentence of subsection XIX of section 3 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 430 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'except that paid holidays when occurring in a totally or partially unemployed week shall not be deducted from the unemployment compensation to which the employee is entitled.'
