RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey the Interest of the State (Maine Forestry District) in a Lot of Land in the Town of Brownville.

Authorizing forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey the interest of the state of Maine (Maine Forestry District) in a lot of land in the town of Brownville, to the highest bidder, but not less than \$100, the income to be credited to the Maine Forestry District.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lot of land, 150 feet square, on the westerly side of the state highway from Brownville to Brownville Junction, was purchased by the Maine Forestry District in 1935 for a storehouse site, from Llewellyn Jones. In 1945 the storehouse burned and was rebuilt at a new and better location. Several persons are interested in purchasing this vacant lot which now is of no use to this department.
