RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey the Interest of the State in Lot 102, in St. Agatha.

Forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey the interest of the state of Maine, in and to, lot 102, in St. Agatha, to the highest bidder, but not less than \$200.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lot, containing 79.5 acres, is part of the original public domain which was never sold when the land agent allotted the town. A survey of the lot shows there is 37.6 acres in alders and bushes, 4.8 acres in poplar 4"-8" D.B.H., .5 acre in bog, 32.1 acres of spruce, fir and tamarack 2"-6" D.B.H., and 4.5 acres in open field and cut-over land.

It is difficult for the state to give this small area economical supervision.

The lot was burned over 30 years ago and the soil is thin and rocky, making it useless for farming land.
