SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 324,  
L. D. 392, Bill "An Act Relating to Minimum  
Salaries for Teachers."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the word "sentence"  
in the 3rd line of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in place  
thereof the word 'sentence'.

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end of the  
3rd paragraph the following underlined sentence: 'Any city,  
town, plantation or community school district which fails to  
comply with any of these conditions shall have deducted from  
its apportionment a sum equal to that by which it is delinquent.'
